Abstract: Provides relative to literacy services for certain public school students in 6th through 12th grade.

Proposed law creates opportunities for certain public school students in 6th through the 12th grade to receive literacy instruction and reading support services.

Proposed law provides that a public school student who is in all of the following categories is eligible:

- (1) Enrolled in the sixth through 12th grade.
- (2) Reads below grade level.
- (3) Is over-age for the grade in which he is enrolled, as defined by the state Dept. of Education.

Proposed law requires the state Dept. of Education to:

- (1) Develop an application process and accept applications for service providers.
- (2) Evaluate service providers for eligibility.
- (3) Annually report to the House and Senate education committees regarding services rendered.

Proposed law requires public school governing authorities to notify the parents or legal guardians of eligible students of the services available.

Proposed law requires school districts to include proposed law purposes in their Education Excellence Fund expenditure plans.
