HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 15

HEALTH: Requests the Board of Regents to purchase chest compression devices for certain public postsecondary education institutions

1	A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION
2	To urge and request the Board of Regents to purchase chest compression devices for certain
3	public universities throughout the state.
4	WHEREAS, sudden cardiac arrest, the abrupt and unexpected loss of heart function,
5	is a major cause of death worldwide, affecting an estimated 300,000 to 450,000 people in
6	the U.S. every year; and
7	WHEREAS, there is a great likelihood that if a cardiac event occurs on a college
8	campus, it will happen at a stadium, arena, or athletic training facility; and
9	WHEREAS, chest compression devices help deliver high quality chest compressions
0	for adults in need of receiving cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) in response to a sudden
1	cardiac arrest; CPR is incredibly physically demanding; and
12	WHEREAS, the availability of a chest compression device on a college campus
13	would support healthcare providers in concentrating on the many critical, real-time decisions
4	that must be made when responding to a cardiac event.
15	THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislature of Louisiana does hereby
16	urge and request the Board of Regents to purchase chest compression devices for certain
17	public universities throughout the state.
18	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that one device is hereby requested for each of the
