Amendments proposed by Senate Committee on Insurance to Original Senate Bill No. 163 by Senator Talbot

1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

2 On page 2, between lines 9 and 10, insert the following:

3 "(9) An explanation to let a policyholder know that if a policyholder files 4 an insurance claim for damages to a property that has a mortgage loan, the 5 policyholder needs to immediately notify the lender or mortgage servicer for 6 that property to let the lender or servicer know an insurance claim has been 7 filed. (10) An explanation to let a policyholder know that if a policyholder 8 9 receives an insurance settlement for damages on a property that has a mortgage 10 loan, the policyholder may need to contact the lender or servicer for that property, as the lender or mortgage servicer may be a named payee on the 11 check, and if so, the policyholder will need the lender or mortgage servicer to 12 endorse the check in order to receive the funds. 13 (11) The process for filing a complaint with the Office of Financial 14 15 Institutions if there is any dissatisfaction with how the lender or mortgage 16 servicer handled the disbursement of the insurance proceeds."
