

1 Bureau of Indian Affairs to take such steps as are necessary to effect, in the near future,
2 formal recognition of the Apalachee Indians Talimali Band, to acknowledge that the rights
3 of the Apalachee Indians Talimali Band are no less than those of other Indian tribes in the
4 United States, and to take such executive or congressional action as may be appropriate.

5 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this Resolution be transmitted to the
6 president of the United States, the presiding officers of the Senate and the House of
7 Representatives of the Congress of the United States, each member of the Louisiana
8 Congressional delegation, the director of the Bureau of Indian Affairs, the United States
9 Department of the Interior, and the leadership of the Apalachee Indians Talimali Band.
