# CAPITAL OUTLAY: Provides for the comprehensive Capital Outlay budget

1	AN ACT
2	To provide with respect to the capital outlay budget and the capital outlay program for state
3	government, state institutions, and other public entities; to provide for the
4	designation of projects and improvements; to provide for the financing thereof
5	making appropriations from certain sources; and to provide for related matters.
6	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
7	Section 1. The following sums or so much thereof as may be necessary are hereby
8	appropriated out of any monies in the state treasury from the sources specified, from federal
9	funds and self-generated revenues belonging to the state of Louisiana and/or collected by
10	boards, commissions, departments, and agencies thereof, all for making capital outlay and
11	for the purposes and in the amounts specified herein for the Fiscal Year commencing July
12	1, 2022, and ending June 30, 2023, subject to the conditions thereafter provided:
13	A project with funding payable from General Obligation Bonds Priority 1 indicates
14	that the funding for the project includes the reauthorization of funding which was previously
15	granted as a line of credit by the State Bond Commission in Fiscal Year 2021-2022. As used
16	in this Section, the term "general obligation bonds" means state general obligation bonds or
17	other evidences of indebtedness payable from the Bond Security and Redemption Fund. The
18	amount set forth in this Section opposite each project, or so much thereof as may be
19	necessary, is hereby appropriated and payable from the source of funding indicated;
20	provided, however, amounts appropriated and payable from federal funds may be
21	encumbered or expended only to the extent such amounts shall have been committed or

received. Pursuant to the provisions of R.S. 39:82, funds for planning, acquisition,
 construction, and major repair projects appropriated by this Act may be retained until
 completion of the project, even if no bona fide liability exists on the last day of the fiscal
 year.

5 This Act shall constitute the comprehensive state capital outlay budget for the 2022-6 2023 Fiscal Year. Projects set forth which are payable from the proceeds available from the 7 sale of general obligation bonds shall have the priorities as indicated. The Request for Line 8 of Credit form used by the attorney general and Bond Counsel in evaluating Louisiana 9 Constitutional, Internal Revenue Code, and applicable income tax regulations shall be filed 10 with the commissioner of administration, State Bond Commission, and state attorney 11 general. No general obligation bond cash lines of credit shall be granted to fund any lower 12 priority project prior to the granting of general obligation bond cash lines of credit to fund 13 all higher priority projects (the "general rule"), except as hereinafter provided. This 14 prohibition against funding a lower priority project shall not apply upon a showing of an 15 impossibility or impracticality either to proceed with all unfunded higher priority projects 16 or to proceed with the funding of such projects or any part thereof through the issuance of 17 general obligation bonds for any reason. Such showing shall be stated in reasonable detail 18 in a certificate or certificates signed by the state agency responsible for administering the 19 funding, and filed with the commissioner of administration and the State Bond Commission 20 (hereinafter referred to as "the Commission"). Upon a determination by the Commission 21 that proceeding with such a project or the funding thereof through the issuance of general 22 obligation bonds is impractical or impossible, the Commission may then proceed with the 23 sale of general obligation bonds or the granting of cash lines of credit without regard to the 24 priority of the unfunded projects determined to be impossible or impractical.

Upon recommendation by the state agency responsible for administering the funding, if it is determined at any time that proceeding with the project or with the funding thereof is no longer impossible or impractical, the State Bond Commission may rescind the certificate of impossibility or impracticality and may proceed with the project or with the issuance of general obligation bonds or the granting of cash lines of credit to fund the project. Alternatively, the Interim Emergency Board (hereinafter referred to as "the Board"),

1 upon reviewing certificates as described above and determining that proceeding with such 2 projects or the funding thereof through the issuance of general obligation bonds is 3 impossible or impractical, may designate a lower priority for such projects. The Board's 4 determination and lower priority designation shall be submitted to the members of the 5 legislature for their approval in accordance with the provisions of Chapter 3-B of Subtitle 6 I of Title 39 of the Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950. In accordance with the provisions 7 of Chapter 3-B of Subtitle I of Title 39 of the Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950, whenever 8 at the written request of the appropriate legislators and agency, the Board determines that 9 an adjustment to a project description originally set forth in such capital budget adopted by 10 the legislature for a current fiscal year is necessary to correct a mistake in a project 11 description, clarify a description, change the scope of a description, or make any other 12 adjustment the Board deems necessary to implement the purpose of the project, such 13 adjustment shall become effective only upon the approval by majority vote of the elected 14 members of each house of the legislature in the manner provided for in Chapter 3-B of 15 Subtitle I of Title 39 of the Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950.

16 If such approval is granted, notification by the chair or secretary of the Board of the 17 results of the balloting shall be transmitted to the State Bond Commission, which may then 18 proceed with the sale of general obligation bonds or the granting of cash lines of credit for 19 each change approved upon request of the commissioner of administration in accordance 20 with the general rule.

21 With respect to Priorities 1 through 5, a lower priority project may be moved to a 22 higher priority only upon a showing of an emergency or other cause not reasonably 23 anticipated by the legislature, which shall be stated in reasonable detail in a certificate signed 24 by the head of the appropriate department, political subdivision, or agency and filed with the 25 commissioner of administration and the Board. Upon a determination by the Board that such 26 project should be moved to a higher priority because of an emergency or other cause not 27 reasonably anticipated by the legislature, the Board shall designate a higher priority to the 28 project. The matter then shall be submitted to and be subject to the same approval by the 29 members of the legislature in the manner previously indicated in this Section. If such 30 approval is granted, notification by the chair or secretary of the board of the change of

1 priority shall be transmitted to the State Bond Commission, which then upon request of the 2 commissioner of administration, may proceed with the sale of general obligation bonds or 3 the granting of cash lines of credit in accordance with the general rule. As to projects within 4 a priority, the State Bond Commission acting on requests submitted by the commissioner of 5 administration shall determine when such project, or phases thereof, shall be funded. In 6 making such determination, the State Bond Commission shall consider the amount of 7 proceeds of general obligation bonds to be made available in light of money and capital 8 market conditions; the expenditure requirements of the project; the time required for 9 architectural plans and drawings, public bidding, and site acquisition and preparation; 10 availability of receipt of federal monies; litigation affecting the undertaking or completion 11 of a project; federal tax laws and regulations regarding the sale of municipal bonds; and 12 other items of a similar nature bearing upon the possibility or the necessity to commence a 13 project or any particular phase thereof.

14 Any other provision of this Act to the contrary notwithstanding, projects described 15 in Priority 5 of this Act shall not be moved to a higher priority except upon one of the 16 following conditions: (1) Funding is necessary to complete or additionally fund a project 17 located elsewhere in the Capital Outlay Act. Determination of such condition shall be made 18 by the head of the appropriate department or agency by means of a certificate to that effect 19 filed with the Interim Emergency Board, who shall, by mail ballot, request approval of such 20 change and if approved by a majority of each house of the legislature it shall be funded, or 21 (2) unless required by an emergency or other cause not reasonably anticipated by the 22 legislature, to be in accordance with procedures set forth in this Section. However, the State 23 Bond Commission may authorize a non-cash line of credit for any project in Priority 5 which 24 represents that portion of construction contracts which were let during a previous fiscal year, 25 or construction contracts which will be let during the current fiscal year, but which will not 26 require cash expenditures during the year. Such non-cash lines of credit, when combined 27 with previously sold bonds or with higher priority bonds or lines of credit, or with funds 28 appropriated from other sources, will provide sufficient appropriated funds to award 29 equipment or construction contracts. Contracts shall not be awarded without approval of the 30 division of administration.

1 Upon approval by the State Bond Commission, and subject to compliance with its 2 policies and procedures and the procedures set forth herein, a line of credit providing for the 3 use of funds in anticipation of the sale of general obligation bonds may be granted to the 4 appropriate administering agency or department from the Comprehensive Capital Outlay 5 Escrow Account, or if there is not a sufficient amount available in such account, from other 6 available state cash in the state treasury, for capital improvement projects for which bond 7 proceeds are appropriated by a current capital budget, prior to the actual issuance of bonds 8 for such projects, unless the attorney general advises that an impediment exists to the valid 9 issuance of the bonds on the date such line of credit is granted.

All bonds that are to be repaid, in whole or in part, by revenues generated by the project shall be designated as "Reimbursement Bonds." The State Bond Commission shall enter into such agreements as are necessary to provide that the agency or subdivision, whose project is reimbursable, shall pay the bond debt costs into the Bond Security and Redemption Fund. Such costs may be paid annually or at the end of the term of the bonds issued as determined by the State Bond Commission.

16 Priority 1 general obligation bond funding shall be limited to:

17 (1) Projects and amounts which were previously authorized by Act 485 of the 2021
18 Regular Session of the Legislature; and which were granted cash lines of credit by the State
19 Bond Commission. The bonds to fund these projects were not sold in Fiscal Year 202120 2022.

(2) The reauthorization of the portion of the outstanding Fiscal Year 2021-2022
Priority 5 Non-Cash Lines of Credit for projects which will require cash expenditures in
Fiscal Year 2022-2023 and therefore must be converted to Cash Lines of Credit in Fiscal
Year 2022-2023.

25 (3) Commitments made in the Higher Education Desegregation Settlement26 Agreement.

27 Priority 2 general obligation bond projects are for the completion of plans and 28 specifications, land acquisition, site preparation, or for construction which will begin during 29 the fiscal year. It is presently anticipated that the listed projects will require the sale of 30 bonds or extension of lines of credit during the fiscal year after adoption of this Act.

Priority 3 general obligation bond projects are for the preparation of plans and specifications, land acquisition, site preparation, or for construction and shall be limited to funding for the portion of construction contracts which will not require cash expenditures during the fiscal year. The projects in this category shall be considered future year projects in the state's five-year capital outlay plan. It is presently anticipated that the listed projects will not require the sale of bonds or extension of lines of credit during the fiscal year.

Priority 4 general obligation bond projects are for the preparation of plans and specifications, land acquisition, site preparation, or for construction and shall be limited to funding for the portion of construction contracts which will not require cash expenditures during the fiscal year. The projects in this category shall be considered future year projects in the state's five-year capital outlay plan. It is presently anticipated that the listed projects will not require the sale of bonds or extension of lines of credit during the fiscal year.

Priority 5 general obligation bond funding shall be limited to funding for the portion of construction contracts which will not require cash expenditures during the fiscal year. These funds, when combined with previously sold bonds or with higher priority bonds on lines of credit, or with funds appropriated from other sources, will provide sufficient appropriated funds to award contracts. Non-cash lines of credit shall be required prior to the award of these contracts.

19 In accordance with the cash management plan adopted pursuant to R.S. 48:251(D) 20 and the provisions of Act 161 of the 1998 First Extraordinary Session, the Department of 21 Transportation and Development is authorized to enter into contracts or agreements for 22 projects approved pursuant to the Highway Priority Program, Airport Construction and 23 Development Priority Program, Port Construction and Development Priority Program, and 24 Statewide Flood Control Program for projects bid and awarded, authorized, or commenced 25 during the fiscal year which do not require cash expenditures for the full contract or 26 agreement amount.

37 Notwithstanding anything contained in this Capital Outlay Act, or any previous Capital 38 Outlay Act to the contrary, or any other provision of law, the Department of Public Safety 39 and Corrections may finance the design, construction, furnishing and equipping of 40 replacement facilities through the issuance of revenue bonds by the Louisiana Correctional 41 Facilities Corporation to be secured by and payable from State appropriations. The issuance 42 of such revenue bonds shall require the approval of the State Bond Commission.

43	Section 2. The expenditure of funds appropriated in this Act, except
44	appropriations made to nonprofit economic development corporations, shall be in conformity
45	to all existing statutes relative to public bidding, contractual review, and R.S. 39:101 through
46	128 and any other statutes affecting the capital outlay program for state government, state

institutions, and political entities. No contract shall be awarded for any project prior to the
granting of a line of credit or the sale of bonds by the State Bond Commission, determination
by the state treasurer that cash funding is available in the Comprehensive Capital Outlay
Escrow Account for the project, or delivery of revenue bonds whose issuance is authorized
in Section 1 or Section 1.(A) of this Act.

6 Section 3. Payment for projects specified in this Act must be made by warrant 7 submitted to the division of administration, Department of Transportation and Development, 8 the state treasurer or other administering agency as provided in Section 8, whichever is 9 appropriate, only to the extent of funds required for immediate payment. Copies of invoices 10 or other supporting documentation shall be submitted with warrants. In the event that any 11 equipment included in this Act, is procured pursuant to the provisions of the State Lease-12 Purchase Act, R.S. 39:1761 et seq., the amounts included in this Act for each such piece of 13 equipment shall not be appropriated. The provisions of R.S. 39:1771 which require 14 equipment to be leased under the State Lease-Purchase Act to be included in the executive 15 budget and approved by the legislature through inclusion in the General Appropriation Act 16 shall be considered waived upon the inclusion of such equipment in this Act. Projects 17 contained in this Act may, at the direction of the division of administration and with the 18 approval of the State Bond Commission, alternatively be funded through financing programs 19 heretofore or hereafter provided by a public trust and public corporation duly organized 20 pursuant to R.S. 9:2341 et seq., having for its beneficiary the state and the Louisiana Local 21 Government Environmental Facilities and Community Development Authority, pursuant to 22 R.S. 33:4548.1 et seq.

23 Section 4. If at any time during the Fiscal Year 2022-2023, the governor should 24 find, or the Joint Legislative Committee on the Budget or the commissioner of 25 administration should report to the governor, that the receipts of the treasury are falling short 26 or appear likely to fall short of the revenue estimates for the fiscal year and that a cash 27 deficit is likely to be incurred, the governor shall take such steps as deemed necessary to 28 prevent the occurrence of a cash deficit. In the event that a capital outlay project funded in 29 this Act falls under an agency which is abolished or for which funds are not appropriated in 30 the 2022-2023 General Appropriation Act, then the funds appropriated in this Act for such

capital outlay projects shall not be expended unless deemed necessary by the governor to
 protect life or property. In the event that legislation is enacted which transfers facilities or
 programs for which projects are funded in this Act, on behalf of one agency, institution,
 department, or management board to another agency, institution, department, or management
 board, then the projects in this Act shall be deemed transferred also.

6 Section 5. All monies appropriated by this Act and any applicable funds of a 7 prior capital outlay budget act adopted by the legislature shall be deposited by the state 8 treasurer in the Comprehensive Capital Outlay Escrow Account, established by this Section, 9 in the state treasury. In accordance with R.S. 36:764, no later than sixty days following the 10 end of each quarter, the state treasurer shall report to the Joint Legislative Committee on the 11 Budget and the commissioner of administration, all funds contained in the Miscellaneous 12 Fund of the Comprehensive Capital Outlay Escrow Account. Notwithstanding any 13 provisions contained herein or other law to the contrary, any original issue premium or 14 accrued interest proceeds received pursuant to the sale of general obligation bonds shall 15 remain on deposit to the credit of the Bond Security and Redemption Fund until such time 16 as they may be utilized in accordance with U.S. Department of the Treasury Regulations 17 promulgated pursuant to the Internal Revenue Code of 1986. All such monies shall be 18 administered according to the particular Act pertaining to the fiscal year in which such 19 monies were appropriated. If it is determined by the director of the office of facility 20 planning and control, division of administration, that the funds appropriated by this Act or 21 any prior capital outlay budget Act are not sufficient to complete the projects contained in 22 any capital outlay budget Act, through unavoidable deficiencies in appropriation, including 23 administrative and legal requirements, the commissioner of administration, subject to 24 approval of the Joint Legislative Committee on the Budget, may direct the use of interest 25 earned from the investment of general obligation bond or note proceeds in the 26 Comprehensive Capital Outlay Escrow Account, not to exceed an aggregate of five million 27 dollars in any one fiscal year, for the purpose of completing the projects contained in any 28 capital outlay budget Act and such money shall be deemed appropriated in specific amounts 29 necessary for such purpose. All appropriations in this Act which are made as additions to 30 funds for previously authorized projects shall be included, for accounting purposes, in the

1 account of the previously authorized projects. If it is determined by the director of the office 2 of facility planning and control, division of administration, that it is cost effective and 3 practical to combine individual appropriations, the commissioner of administration, subject 4 to the approval of the Joint Legislative Committee on the Budget, may direct that two or 5 more appropriations or parts thereof may be combined into a single project for accounting 6 and audit purposes. The commissioner of administration may direct that funding in the 7 various statewide and/or multiple parish projects for improvements for state facilities may 8 be transferred to any project, in this Act or any previous Capital Outlay Act, which require 9 supplemental funding for improvements for state facilities which qualify for funding through 10 the various statewide and/or multiple parish projects for improvements for state facilities. 11 The office of facility planning and control, division of administration is authorized to receive 12 settlements and vendor rebates and to add a portion or all of these receipts to the existing 13 project funds relating to the settlement and/or vendor rebates and appropriated in this Act 14 or any previous Capital Outlay Act including those previously appropriated funds that 15 become unavailable. Approval by the Joint Legislative Committee on the Budget will be 16 obtained if the settlement and/or vendor rebates will be added to any projects in this Act or 17 any previous Capital Outlay Act which are unrelated to the project from which the settlement and/or vendor rebates were received. The office of facility planning and control, division 18 19 of administration is authorized to receive insurance payments and are hereby authorized to 20 immediately repair facilities that suffer insurance losses without those projects being 21 included in the Act and shall report to the Joint Legislative Committee on the Budget any 22 expenditures from insurance funds received pursuant to this Section. A portion, as 23 determined by the commissioner of administration and not to exceed one percent (1%), of 24 the funding for projects which qualify for the Percent for Art Program and not to exceed 25 \$450,000 for an individual, qualifying project, may be transferred from the qualifying 26 project budgets, to the Department of Culture, Recreation and Tourism for costs of acquiring 27 art and administering the program. For all Percent for Art Program projects in this or any 28 previous capital outlay act, up to ten percent (10%) of the aforementioned one percent (1%)29 may be used for the costs of administering the projects.

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Section 6. No later than February 1, 2023, agencies administering capital outlay 2 projects will submit reports identifying completed projects and cash balances to the Joint 3 Legislative Committee on Capital Outlay pursuant to the reporting requirements of R.S. 4 39:105 and R.S. 39:116.

5 Section 7. The commissioner of administration, with the approval of the Joint 6 Legislative Committee on the Budget, is authorized to supplement or substitute the 7 appropriations specified in this or previous capital outlay acts with any federal or other funds 8 which are or may become available and such funds shall be deemed appropriated in specific 9 amounts necessary for the purposes of this Act. Any funds received by the State Bond 10 Commission as a result of a prepayment of reimbursement contracts as authorized by law 11 and the policy and procedure for reimbursement contracts of the Department of Treasury, 12 office of State Bond Commission, shall be deposited as set forth in such policy and 13 procedure and shall be deemed available and appropriated in specific amounts necessary for 14 the purposes of this Act pursuant to the procedure set forth in this section.

15 Section 8.(A) All projects herein authorized and funded shall be subject to the 16 provisions of R.S. 39:101 through 128. With the exception of appropriations made to the 17 Department of Military Affairs, the Legislature, the Louisiana Stadium and Exposition 18 District, the Department of Economic Development, the Coastal Protection and Restoration 19 Authority, the Division of Administration for Supplemental State Funds for Local 20 Government Assistance Program, the Division of Administration for the Community Water 21 Enrichment Program or the Department of Transportation and Development, all funds herein 22 appropriated shall be considered as having been appropriated directly to the Office of 23 Facility Planning and Control, Division of Administration. All cooperative endeavor 24 agreements for non-state entities shall be prepared by the appropriate administering agency 25 and submitted to the office of State Procurement for review and approval. As part of its 26 review, the office of State Procurement shall consult with bond counsel to the State relative 27 to any federal tax issues.

28 (1) Notwithstanding anything contained in this act to the contrary or any other 29 provision of law, the appropriations made for the Louisiana Stadium and Exposition District 30 shall be appropriated directly to the Louisiana Stadium and Exposition District, and are

1 public purposes pursuant to the provisions of Article VII, Section 14 of the Constitution of 2 Louisiana primarily for economic development, including the generation of tax revenue, 3 creation of jobs, and the generation of tourism, and may be used to reimburse any 4 expenditure made prior to the granting of a line of credit or the sale of bonds by the State 5 Bond Commission, determination by the State Treasurer that cash funding has been 6 deposited in the Comprehensive Capital Outlay Escrow Account for the project.

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(2) Further, with respect to appropriations to the Louisiana Stadium and 8 Exposition District for the TPC Louisiana, Planning and Construction project, the Louisiana 9 Stadium and Exposition District shall be permitted to use alternative competitive 10 procurement and delivery methods for the award of any contracts to be funded through such 11 appropriation.

12 (3) The Louisiana Stadium and Exposition District shall have the authority to 13 directly appoint a design professional from a list of a minimum of three architectural firms 14 or joint ventures with professional sports facility design experience acceptable to the 15 Commissioner of Administration and shall be exempt from other state requirements for 16 selection of designers. The design professional fee shall be in accordance with state 17 guidelines administered by the Office of Facility Planning and Control, Division of 18 Administration.

19 (B)(1)(a) Funds appropriated in the Capital Outlay Act under the name of non-20 state entities shall be administered by the Office of Facility Planning and Control, Division 21 of Administration under cooperative endeavor agreements; however, projects involving state 22 or federal highways may be administered by the Department of Transportation and 23 Development, if appropriate. Except as provided in Section 8(A), cooperative endeavor 24 agreements entered into pursuant to appropriations in this Act shall not be required to be 25 submitted to the Division of Administration, Office of State Procurement.

26 (b) Further, for all projects in the Capital Outlay Act or a previous Capital Outlay 27 Act which are appropriated to the Office of Facility Planning and Control, Division of 28 Administration, including those administered by cooperative endeavor agreements, up to six 29 percent of each line-item may be used for costs of administering the projects.

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(c) For all projects in Capital Outlay Act or a previous Capital Outlay Act appropriated to the Department of Transportation and Development, up to six percent of each line-item may be used for costs of administering the projects, or for field engineering/construction supervision.

5 (2) Notwithstanding anything in this Act, or a previous Capital Outlay Act, the 6 Office of Facility Planning and Control may enter into a cooperative endeavor agreement 7 with the Archdiocese of New Orleans and Jefferson Parish for the Preservation and 8 Restoration of Historic Structure for Hope Haven/Madonna Manor Campus, Planning and 9 Construction project.

10 (C) Line-item general obligation bond projects appropriated to the Department 11 of Transportation and Development in the Capital Outlay Act or a previous Capital Outlay 12 Act shall be authorized to draw Transportation Trust Funds from the Highway Program 13 appropriation, for supplemental funding on overruns in excess of the original estimated 14 project cost as determined by the Department of Transportation and Development, provided 15 however that said projects are in the state or federal highway system and in the priority 16 program, and the overrun is less than \$50,000. Any such overrun of \$50,000 or more must 17 be approved by the Joint Legislative Committee on the Budget.

18 (D) All ports, levee districts and other non-state entities must have a fully 19 executed cooperative endeavor agreement, from the administering agency or the State 20 Treasurer, whichever is appropriate, before entering into any contracts which obligate state 21 funding and must follow all laws pertaining to public bidding. If a port, levee district or other 22 non-state entity enters into a contract prior to receipt of funding, or prior to execution of a 23 cooperative endeavor agreement, then payments under such contracts are prohibited from 24 capital outlay appropriations, and are the sole responsibility of the port, levee district, or 25 other non-state entity.

(E) Pursuant to R.S. 39:122(B)(2), funds to be reimbursed by the state which a
non-state entity attempts to obligate prior to the receipt of funding shall not be eligible for
reimbursement or payment by the state; however, notwithstanding anything in this Act or
any previous Capital Outlay Acts to the contrary, contracts may be entered into for the
Lafayette Economic Development Authority, Lafayette Innovation Center (Lafayette) prior

- 1 to the receipt of funding and the State is authorized to financially participate in obligations 2 created by such contracts.

(F) Pursuant to R.S. 39:112(E)(2), non-state entity projects shall require a match of not less than twenty-five percent of the total requested amount of funding.

5 (G) Notwithstanding anything contained in this Act or the Capital Outlay Act 6 to the contrary or any other Act or provision of law, the appropriations made for the 7 Executive Department for facilities which promote economic development included in the 8 Repair, Restoration, and Replacement for Declared Disasters, Planning, Construction, 9 Renovation, and Acquisition project, and the Department of Economic Development projects 10 are for public purposes pursuant to the provisions of Article VII, Section 14 of the 11 Constitution of Louisiana primarily for economic development, including the generation of 12 tax revenues, creation of jobs, promotion of tourism, and creation of facilities for charitable, 13 cultural, artistic, educational, social, civic, research, service, economic development 14 activities, or provide facilities for professional golf events, pursuant to the terms of 15 cooperative endeavor agreements, including leases and all expenditures of these 16 appropriations and may be exempted, by the Commissioner of Administration, from all 17 statutes relative to public bidding, contractual review and the provisions of R.S. 18 33:9029.2(D) and in lieu thereof be allowed to use alternative competitive contracting 19 arrangements where the appropriate administering entity submits documentation to the 20 Commissioner of Administration substantiating that it is in the best interest of the citizens 21 of the state, due to economic and/or operational benefits, and the necessity to complete the 22 projects in a timely manner; and, the appropriate administering entity shall have the 23 authority to directly appoint the design professional from a list of a minimum of three design 24 firms or joint ventures with the appropriate specialized facility design experience submitted 25 to and acceptable to the Commissioner of Administration and shall be exempt from other 26 state requirements for selection of designers, and may include expenditures for computers, 27 fixtures, furniture, and other equipment as such is deemed to be capital outlay in 28 nature, and unless the Commissioner of Administration is advised by bond counsel to the 29 State that such may violate federal tax law, may be used to reimburse any expenditure made 30 prior to the granting of a line of credit or the sale of bonds by the State Bond Commission,

1 determination by the State Treasurer that cash funding has been deposited in the 2 Comprehensive Capital Outlay Escrow Account for the project or the execution of a 3 cooperative endeavor agreement from the Office of Facility Planning and Control, and may 4 be used to acquire land or real property, the title to which is held in the name of an entity 5 exempt from taxation under the provisions of 26 U.S.C. 501(c)(3).

6 (H) Notwithstanding any other provision of this Act or the Capital Outlay Act 7 or any other provision of law to the contrary, all of the funds herein appropriated to the 8 Department of Economic Development in connection with projects or programs for 9 which the Department of Economic Development utilizes a cooperative endeavor agreement 10 to further economic development as permitted under Article VII, Section 14 of the 11 Louisiana Constitution, including the generation of tax revenues and creation of jobs, shall 12 be considered as having been appropriated to the Department of Economic Development, 13 may be used to reimburse any expenditure made prior to the granting of a line of credit and 14 made prior to the execution of a cooperative endeavor agreement and shall be administered 15 solely by the Department of Economic Development pursuant to, in compliance with, and 16 on the terms contained in such cooperative endeavor agreements without compliance with 17 anyother law, including, but not limited to, the provisions of R.S. 39:101 through 128. Additionally, all expenditures of these appropriations may be exempted by the 18 19 Commissioner of Administration, from all statutes relative to public bidding, contractual 20 review and the provisions of R.S. 33:9029.2(D).

21 (I)(1) Notwithstanding any other provision of this Act or the Capital Outlay Act 22 or any other provision of law to the contrary, funds appropriated for the Economic 23 Development Award Program project for the Office of Business Development are to be used 24 solely for capital and infrastructure improvements subject to verification by the Division of 25 Administration, Office of Facility Planning and Control.

26

(2) Eligible expenses for Economic Development Award Program funds may 27 include documented project expenses beginning on the date of LEDC Board approval of the project and may be reimbursed upon execution of the cooperative endeavor agreement for 28 29 the project.

(J)(1) Due to the state's current investment in TPC Louisiana and the financial
 support it provides to the PGA TOUR event currently played at said facility, said PGA
 TOUR event shall not be played at New Orleans City Park Golf Complex without the prior
 agreement of the Commissioner of Administration and the Chairman of the Jefferson Parish
 Council.

6 (2) Notwithstanding the foregoing, the City Park Golf Complex may host any 7 other golf tournament or event, including but not limited to any other PGA-affiliated or 8 sponsored tournament or event.

9 (K)(1) For all projects administered by the Office of Facility Planning and 10 Control and payable from proceeds of self-generated revenues, funds shall be remitted to the 11 Office of Facility Planning and Control for deposit in the state treasury at such time as may 12 be deemed necessary by the Office of Facility Planning and Control in order to cover the 13 amount of contracts or other project expenses.

1 (M) Notwithstanding anything contained in this Act to the contrary or any other 2 provision of law, the resolution adopted by the Joint Legislative Committee on the Budget 3 (the committee) on March 19, 2019 approving State of Louisiana Grant Anticipation 4 Revenue Bonds, in one or more series, not exceeding \$650,000,000, and approving the 5 related projects and providing for other matters in connection therewith, contains the 6 following approvals:

(1) The first series of bonds in the original principal amount of not exceeding
\$185,000,000 in order to fund the following projects in the following estimated amounts:
Barksdale Project (\$61,600,000) and portions of the Loyola Project (\$77,600,000) and the
I-10 Project (\$30,601,000) with the understanding that the Department has the ability to
manage the actual application of bond proceeds in order to appropriately fund the Projects
and meet expenditure requirements of the Internal Revenue Service.

13 (2) The second series of bonds for the express purpose of granting the required 14 contracts in the principal amount of approximately \$142,000,000 in order to fund the 15 following projects in the following estimated amounts: the balance of the Barksdale Project 16 (\$16,518,000), the balance of the Loyola Project (\$87,500,000), portions of the I-10 Project 17 (\$37,982,000) and the Belle Chasse Project (\$12,500,000) with the understanding that the 18 Department has the ability to manage the actual application of Bond proceeds in order to 19 appropriately fund the Projects and meet expenditure requirements of the Internal Revenue 20 Service provided, however, the Department of Transportation and Development seeks 21 approval from the committee for the issuance of the second series of bonds and all 22 subsequent series of bonds.

23 (N) Notwithstanding anything contained in this Act to the contrary or any other 24 provision of law, the Research Vessel (R/V) Pelican Replacement is deemed to be a capital 25 asset and the appropriation to Louisiana Universities Marine Consortium (LUMCON) to 26 replace the R/V Pelican is for a public purpose and has a significant economic impact 27 providing a variety of oceanographic research missions. Further, LUMCON shall be 28 permitted to use an alternative delivery method to award contracts for design of the proposed 29 replacement vessel. LUMCON shall have the authority to select the design professional 30 from a list of a minimum of two engineering firms or joint ventures with ship design

experience acceptable to the Commissioner of Administration and the selection shall be
 exempt from other state requirements for the selection of designers. The design professional
 fee shall be in accordance with state guidelines administered by the Office of Facility
 Planning and Control, Division of Administration. LUMCON shall follow the public bid
 law for the procurement of the replacement vessel.

6 (O) Notwithstanding anything contained in this Act to the contrary or any other 7 provision of law, the appropriations for Major Repairs for Higher Education Facilities -8 Infrastructure, and Buildings Based on Statewide Condition Assessment, Planning and 9 Construction, in Act 7 of 2008 identifying specific projects for higher education is deemed 10 to be complete, and any remaining residual funds are hereby authorized to be combined and 11 accumulated to accomplish additional major repair projects within the higher education 12 systems, as deemed necessary and approved by the Board of Regents and Facility Planning 13 and Control. At the completion of the program, Facility Planning and Control shall submit 14 a report to the Joint Legislative Committee on the Budget concerning the use of the 15 remaining residual funds.

16 (P) Notwithstanding anything contained in this Act or any other provision of law, 17 LSU Real Estate and Facilities Foundation (LRFF) is authorized to execute contracts for the 18 University Lakes Restoration Project to Address Flood Control, Environmental, Safety, 19 Health and Other Issues project prior to execution of a cooperative endeavor agreement, the 20 granting of a line of credit or the sale of bonds. The appropriation for this project may be 21 used to pay any obligation incurred or to reimburse any expenditure made pursuant to such 22 contracts unless the Commissioner of Administration is advised by bond counsel to the state 23 that such may violate federal tax law, after execution of a cooperative endeavor agreement. 24 The Office of Facility Planning and Control shall consult with bond counsel to the State 25 relative to any federal tax issues. Further, LRFF may use alternative competitive contracting 26 arrangements with the prior approval of the Commissioner of Administration.

(Q) Pursuant to R.S. 39:102, each capital outlay budget request submitted as
required by R.S. 39:101 shall include a detailed project description and justification for each
new project requested; however:

1 (1) Notwithstanding anything contained in this Act or the Capital Outlay Act to 2 the contrary or any other provision of law, the scope of the appropriations made in this or 3 any other Capital Outlay Act for the New Orleans West Bank Park Improvements, New 4 Soccer and Recreational Facilities project shall be deemed to include the George W. Carver 5 Playground, Renovations and Upgrades project for the West Bank Park project.

6 (2) Notwithstanding anything contained in this Act or the Capital Outlay Act to 7 the contrary or any other provision of law, the scope of the appropriations made in this or 8 any other Capital Outlay Act for the Pointe Coupee Parish School Board Office Relocation, 9 Due to Flooding Caused by Hurricane Gustav, Planning and Construction project shall be 10 deemed to include that the School Board Office is to be Located at 8777 Morganza 11 Highway.

12 (3) Notwithstanding anything in this Act, any previous capital outlay act, or other 13 provision of law to the contrary, the scope of the appropriation for the Port of South 14 Louisiana Globalplex Terminal Building #71 Upgrade project shall be deemed to also 15 include similar upgrades for other Globalplex Terminal Buildings and a Heavy Load 16 Capacity Foundation or Floor.

17 (4) Notwithstanding anything in this Act, any previous capital outlay Act, or 18 other provision of law to the contrary, monies appropriated herein for the Port of South 19 Louisiana Globalplex Terminal Building #71 and Other Globalplex Terminal Building 20 Upgrades, Planning and Construction may be expended for design fees related to the 21 conveyor system and ancillary equipment that exceed the customary ten percent limitation 22 on design fee costs.

23 (5) Notwithstanding anything in this Act, any previous capital outlay act, or other 24 provision of law to the contrary, the scope of the appropriation for the Port of South 25 Louisiana Globalplex Dock Access Bridge and Equipment Replacement/Repair project shall 26 be deemed to also include an Access Road.

27 (6) Notwithstanding anything in this Act, any previous capital outlay act, or other 28 provision of law to the contrary, the scope of the appropriation for the Port of South 29 Louisiana Globalplex Rail Siding project shall be deemed to also include a Rail Spur.

(7) Notwithstanding anything contained in this Act or the Capital Outlay Act to
 the contrary or any other provision of law, the scope of the appropriations made in this or
 any other Capital Outlay Act for the Pontchartrain Levee District Lake Pontchartrain West
 Shore Hurricane Protection, Planning and Construction project shall be deemed to include
 Ascension Parish.

6 (8) Notwithstanding anything contained in this Act or the Capital Act to the 7 contrary or any other provision of law, the scope of the appropriation made in this or any 8 other Capital Outlay Act for the Statewide Roofing Asset Management Program and 9 Waterproofing, Related Repairs and Equipment Replacement Program project shall be 10 deemed to include Peltier Hall at Nicholls State University.

(R) Notwithstanding anything contained in this Act or any other provision of
law, all non-state projects that include water systems in the scope of work shall also be
required to include a rate study as part of the project.

Section 9. Notwithstanding any provisions contained herein or any other law to
the contrary, the provisions of Chapter 16 of Subtitle III of Title 39 of the Louisiana Revised
Statutes of 1950 as amended, shall not apply to architectural and engineering contracts,
administered by the office of facility planning and control, division of administration
pursuant to this or any other capital outlay Act.

19 Section 10. All funds appropriated herein to agencies administering capital 20 outlay projects, on behalf of non-state entities, by cooperative endeavor agreements pursuant 21 to this Act shall be expended within two (2) years from the date of the issuance of the bonds. 22 Agencies administering capital outlay projects pursuant to a cooperative endeavor agreement 23 shall notify the non-state entity of the date the bonds are issued within three (3) months from 24 the issuance thereof. No funds appropriated 21 to the Coastal Protection and Restoration Authority in this Act as a contribution for a project 22 cost-share or otherwise, for the national economic development and national ecosystem 23 restoration components of the Southwest Coastal Louisiana Study shall be used or provided 24 for the expropriation of property or use of eminent domain, except where such funds are to 25 be used to obtain property voluntarily offered for project purposes, where at least seventy-26 five percent of the owners have voluntarily offered the property, or where the record or 27 apparent owners have voluntarily offered the property but do not have clear title.

Section 14. The word "statewide" used in place of the specific parish designation for projects contained in this Act indicates that the project or program is applicable to all sixty-four parishes in the state. The description of any project in this Act shall be deemed

1 to include planning, design, master planning, studies, permits, surveys, testing, construction, 2 land and/or building/improvement acquisition, reconstruction, renovation, repair, right-of-3 way and utilities, site and other improvements, miscellaneous/contingencies, lease hold 4 improvements ultimately owned by the state or a political subdivision of the state, equipment 5 and other acquisitions, and any other component of the project if such are included or 6 indicated in the capital outlay request for such projects required by R.S. 39:101 subject to 7 the provisions of Title 39 of the Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950. For new construction 8 or renovation projects, equipment or other acquisitions, which can reasonably be considered 9 necessary for the facility to be functional, may be deemed to be included in the project, even 10 if such equipment or other acquisitions are not included or indicated in the project name or 11 the capital outlay request. When local or federal match is referenced in a project title, but 12 only a portion of the state appropriation is granted a line of credit or otherwise funded, then 13 the amount of local or federal match, required to be made available, may be prorated relative 14 to the amount of state appropriation made available through lines of credit.

Section 15. The provisions, items, and projects contained in this Act are severable and if any provision, item, or project contained herein, or the application of any such provision, item, or project, is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions, items, projects, or applications of the Act which can be given effect without the invalid provision, project, item, or application.

Section 16. Notwithstanding any other provisions of law to the contrary, the state shall not grant cash lines of credit, or authorize or issue general obligation bonds in a principal amount in excess of \$1,236,476,643 for Fiscal Year 2022-2023.

Section 17. Notwithstanding any contrary provision of this Act or any contrary provision of law, no funds appropriated by this Act shall be released or provided to any recipient of an appropriation made in this Act if, when, and for as long as, the recipient fails or refuses to comply with the provisions of R.S. 24:513. No recipient shall be considered to fail or refuse to comply with the provisions of R.S. 24:513 pursuant to this Section during any extension of time granted by the legislative auditor to the recipient to comply.

Section 18. This Act shall become effective upon signature by the governor or,
if not signed by the governor, upon expiration of the time for bills to become law without

- 1 signature by the governor, as provided in Article III, Section 18 of the Constitution of
- 2 Louisiana. If vetoed by the governor and subsequently approved by the legislature, this Act
- 3 shall become effective on the day following such approval.
