Original House Bill No. 390 by Representative Wright

1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

2 On page 1, line 2, after "enact" delete "R.S. 49:954(C)," and insert "R.S. 49:954(C) and (D),"

3 AMENDMENT NO. 24 On page 1, line 5, after "R.S. 49:954(C)" and before "hereby" delete "is" and insert "and (D)
5 are"6 AMENDMENT NO. 3

7 On page 1, delete lines 8 through 10, insert the following:

8 "C.(1) A rule adopted in accordance with R.S. 49:953 shall expire on June
9 thirtieth of the year following the year of its adoption unless legislation is enacted
10 to continue the effectiveness of the rule to a certain date or indefinitely.11 (2) The postponement of the expiration of a rule does not constitute
12 legislative approval of the rule and is not admissible in any court as evidence of
13 legislative intent.14 D.(1) Prior to the convening of the regular legislative session of each year,
15 each standing committee of the legislature shall hold a public hearing on all rules
16 that were adopted in accordance with this Part in the previous year and that are
17 within the committee's oversight jurisdiction pursuant to R.S. 49:968. House and
18 Senate oversight committees may meet jointly for this purpose.19 (2) The purpose of the hearing is to determine whether such rules should
20 continue in effect or be terminated. The committee shall solicit and accept testimony
21 from the agency that promulgated the rule and other interested parties. At the
22 hearing, each agency shall have the burden of demonstrating a need for the continued
23 existence of the rule.24 (3) In the regular session following such a hearing, the committee may
25 introduce a single piece of legislation authorizing the continuation of the rules
26 approved by the committee."
