## DIGEST 2022 Regular Session

Morris

<u>Present law</u> provides when law enforcement officers determine an operator of a vehicle has a suspended or revoked driver's license at the time of a stop and the vehicle is registered to the operator, the officer shall remove the license plate and issue a notice of suspension on a form as promulgated by the department.

Proposed law retains present law and provides for a physical form or an electronic form.

<u>Proposed law</u> retains <u>present law</u> and further provides the officer can issue an electronic form similar to the physical form provided by the department.

<u>Present law</u> provides when an operator of a motor vehicle fails to produce proof of motor vehicle liability insurance the vehicle shall be impounded and the operator shall be issued a notice of noncompliance on a form to be provided by the department.

<u>Proposed law</u> retains <u>present law</u> and further allows the notice of noncompliance to be issued through an electronic or a physical form.

Effective August 1, 2022.
