
SENATE COMMITTEE AMENDMENTS

Amendments proposed by Senate Committee on Education to Original Senate Bill No. 203
by Senator Hewitt

1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

2 On page 3, between lines 19 and 20, insert the following:

3 **"(c) Provide parents or legal guardians of eligible students printed or**
4 **online resources and materials regarding the importance of reading and how to**
5 **support their child in learning to read."**

6 AMENDMENT NO. 2

7 On page 5, between lines 2 and 3, insert the following:

8 **"(iv) To acknowledge receipt of and utilize any and all resources**
9 **provided by the department to support their child's progress in reading."**

10 AMENDMENT NO. 3

11 On page 5, line 3, change "**(iv)**" to "**(v)**"

12 AMENDMENT NO. 4

13 On page 5, at the end of line 5, insert the following:

14 **"However, the parent of a participating student shall ensure the student**
15 **is complying with the attendance requirements of the participating school or**
16 **service provider. Each participating student who fails to comply with such**
17 **attendance requirements shall be reported to the state director of child welfare**
18 **and attendance by the participating school or service provider and shall be**
19 **subject to the provisions of R.S. 17:233."**

20 AMENDMENT NO. 5

21 On page 5, between lines 27 and 28, insert the following:

22 **"D. If the department finds that a participating school or service**
23 **provider has failed to maintain continuing eligibility criteria or has**
24 **demonstrated gross or a persistent lack of academic competence, the**
25 **department shall restrict the school's ability to serve additional students and**
26 **may be terminated from the program. Such action shall be reported to the state**
27 **board within three business days."**
