WHEREAS, Mr. Anderson leaves to cherish his memory his wife of forty-nine years, René Brouillette Anderson; daughter, Pauline A. Daigre, and her husband Brian; son, Douglas A. Anderson, Jr., and his wife Carrie; grandchildren, Jaxon, Zachary, and Emily; step-grandchildren, Walker, Lola, and West; brother, Don Anderson, and his wife Adele; two nieces; one nephew; and many cousins and friends; he will be deeply missed.
