1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

2 On page 1, line 6, after "definitions;" insert "to provide for an effective date;"

3 AMENDMENT NO. 2

4 On page 2, line 9, after "that" and before "publishes" insert "knowingly and intentionally"

5 AMENDMENT NO. 3

6 On page 2, line 15, after "material" insert a period "." and delete the remainder of the line

7 AMENDMENT NO. 4

8 On page 2, delete line 16 in its entirety

9 AMENDMENT NO. 5

10 On page 2, line 19, after "including" delete "reasonable" and after "and" delete the remainder
11 of the line and insert "reasonable attorney fees as ordered by the court."

12 AMENDMENT NO. 6

13 On page 2, delete lines 20 through 27 in their entirety and insert the following:

14 "(b) A commercial entity that is found to have knowingly retained
15 identifying information of the individual after access has been granted to the
16 individual, shall be liable to the individual for damages resulting from retaining the
17 identifying information, including court costs and reasonable attorney fees as ordered
18 by the court."

19 AMENDMENT NO. 7

20 On page 3, line 4, after "subsidiaries," and before "shall" insert "search engine, or cloud
21 service provider"

22 AMENDMENT NO. 8

23 On page 4, line 6, after "interest," and before "who" insert "while operating as an employee
24 as provided in this Subparagraph,"

25 AMENDMENT NO. 9

26 On page 4, line 10, after "service" and before "who" insert "while operating as an employee
27 as provided in this Subparagraph,"

28 AMENDMENT NO. 10

29 On page 5, after line 3, add the following:

30 "Section 2. This Act shall be effective on January 1, 2023."
