EXPENDITURE EXPLANATION

There will be an increase in SGF expenditures for the Louisiana House of Representatives in order to pay for the work point study as required in the resolution. The Louisiana Supreme Court (LSC) reports receiving the following two proposals from organizations to conduct the study: 1) National Center for State Courts at \$286,000; and 2) Justice Management Institute ranging from \$200,000 to \$275,000. The LSC reports the proposals were obtained one year ago and may need to be updated.

Note: HB 592, providing for supplemental appropriations for FY 22, appropriates \$300,000 to the Legislative Budgetary Control Council for the expenses related to the study required by the HR30.

REVENUE EXPLANATION

There is no anticipated direct material effect on governmental revenues as a result of this measure.
