2 To urge and request the presiding officers of the legislature to study issues created by the 3 columns in the legislative committee rooms and to explore all opportunities to 4 improve conditions or resolve issues involving the line-of-sight issues caused by 5 those columns and to report their findings and recommendations to each member of 6 the legislature not later than January 15, 2023. 7 WHEREAS, several committee rooms in the state capitol have columns that obstruct 8 the line-of-sight during meetings; and 9 WHEREAS, these columns interfere with both the ability of members of the public 10 to adequately see what is occurring during meetings and the ability of legislators and 11 members of other public bodies conducting meetings in those committee rooms to see 12 everyone in the room and occasionally even those persons providing testimony. 13 THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislature of Louisiana does hereby 14 urge and request the presiding officers of the legislature to study issues created by the 15 columns in certain legislative committee rooms and explore all opportunities to improve 16 conditions or resolve issues involving the line-of-sight issues caused by those columns and 17 to report their findings and recommendations to each member of the legislature not later than
