**Abstract:** Provides changes to training requirements of part-time and reserve peace officers beginning employment on or after Jan. 1, 2022, but before Jan. 1, 2024.

<u>Present law</u> provides that any person who begins employment as a peace officer in La. subsequent to Jan. 1, 1986, must successfully complete a certified training program approved by the council and successfully pass a council-approved comprehensive examination within one calendar year from the date of initial employment.

<u>Present law</u> requires any person who begins employment as a part-time or reserve peace officer in La. on or after Jan. 1, 2022, to be subject to the requirements of <u>present law</u>.

<u>Proposed law retains present law</u> and changes the required period for completion of certified training <u>from</u> one calendar year <u>to</u> within two calendar years from the date of initial employment.

Specifies that <u>proposed law</u> shall have retroactive and prospective application.
