#### SUMMARY OF HOUSE AMENDMENTS TO THE SENATE BILL

1. Clarify a discretionary provision that a potential supplier may, but is not required to, submit a particular product for prior approval.

## DIGEST OF THE SENATE BILL AS RETURNED TO THE SENATE

#### **DIGEST**

<u>Present law</u> provides that a supplier of particular products for public works may seek prior approval for brand products other than those specified in the contract documents within seven working days, prior to bid opening.

<u>Proposed law</u> retains <u>present law</u> and adds a potential supplier may, but is not required to, submit a particular product for prior approval other than a product specified in the contract documents, no later than seven working days prior to the opening of bids.

<u>Present law</u> requires the prime design professional furnish written approval or denial of the product submitted within three days, exclusive of holidays and weekends, after submission.

<u>Proposed law</u> retains <u>present law</u> and further provides if the prime design professional does not respond within the allotted time period, the submitted product shall be considered approved.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides for technical corrections.

Effective August 1, 2022.
