1	AN ACT
2	To amend and reenact R.S. 39:198(I)(introductory paragraph), (2), (6), (8)(introductory
3	paragraph), (b), and (c), and (9), relative to contracts for fiscal intermediary services;
4	to provide for the transfer of contract award oversight from the House and Senate
5	committees on health and welfare to the Joint Legislative Committee on the Budget;
6	and to provide for related matters.
7	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
8	Section 1. R.S. 39:198(I)(introductory paragraph), (2), (6), (8)(introductory
9	paragraph), (b), and (c), and (9) are hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows:
10	§198. Types of contracts permitted
11	* * *
12	I. Contracts for fiscal intermediary services. State agencies may enter into
13	contracts for fiscal intermediary services. The term of such a the contract shall be
14	one hundred twenty months. In the event If special circumstances, as provided in
15	Paragraph (9) of this Subsection, necessitate, additional one-year extensions of the
16	contract may be granted. The award process and final contract shall include the
17	following:
18	* * *
19	(2) Justification for the contract shall be submitted to the state central
20	purchasing agency and shall be submitted to the House and Senate committees on
21	health and welfare Joint Legislative Committee on the Budget at least forty-five
22	days prior to the issuance of a solicitation for proposals. Within thirty days of receipt
23	of the justification by the House and Senate committees on health and welfare, either
24	Joint Legislative Committee on the Budget, the committee may convene a meeting
25	separately or jointly for the purpose of conducting conduct a public hearing on the

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1	justification which was submitted. Such This justification shall include identification
2	and consideration of all factors, including costs, relevant to the solicitation for
3	proposals and the final contract.
4	* * *
5	(6) No award of the contract shall be made until the House and Senate
6	committees on health and welfare, meeting jointly or a joint subcommittee thereof
7	Joint Legislative Committee on the Budget has conducted a public hearing
8	concerning such <u>the</u> award.
9	* * *
10	(8) No option to renew such <u>the</u> contract shall be exercised by the state until
11	the following criteria have been satisfied:
12	* * *
13	(b) The Louisiana Department of Health submits to the House and Senate
14	committees on health and welfare Joint Legislative Committee on the Budget a
15	notice of intention by the Louisiana Department of Health to exercise the option to
16	renew such the contract and a copy of any public testimony which was taken at the
17	public hearing held by the Louisiana Department of Health. The House and Senate
18	committees on health and welfare, meeting separately or jointly, Joint Legislative
19	<u>Committee on the Budget</u> may hold a public hearing concerning such <u>the</u> renewal
20	within thirty days following the receipt of a notice of intention by the Louisiana
21	Department of Health to exercise the option to renew such the contract.
22	(c) The House and Senate committees on health and welfare, meeting
23	separately or jointly, have Joint Legislative Committee on the Budget has
24	conducted a public hearing concerning such the renewal or thirty days have elapsed
25	from the date the Louisiana Department of Health submitted a notice of intention to
26	renew such the contract to the House and Senate committees on health and welfare
27	and neither Joint Legislative Committee on the Budget and the committee has not
28	posted a public notice of meeting concerning the renewal of such the contract.
29	(9) In the event the Louisiana Department of Health or the United States
30	Department of Health and Human Services, Centers for Medicare and Medicaid

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1	Services proposes substantial changes in the operations of the Medicaid program that
2	would materially impact the services performed by the fiscal intermediary, the
3	Louisiana Department of Health may, subject to the approval of the House and
4	Senate committees on health and welfare Joint Legislative Committee on the
5	Budget, approve additional extensions of the contract until such time as it is
6	practical to prepare a solicitation for proposals describing the revised services that
7	would be performed by the fiscal intermediary. During the time frame covered by
8	any extension beyond the original one-hundred-twenty-month period, the fiscal
9	intermediary may be required to perform additional functions to assist in preparing
10	the Louisiana Department of Health in the transition to the new program. Such These
11	functions may include existing fiscal intermediary services as well as efforts to
12	control fraud and abuse, program reports, beneficiary enrollment and program
13	information services, encounter data, and annual managed care negotiation data.
