Amendments proposed by House Committee on House and Governmental Affairs to
Original House Bill No. 1 by Representative Duplessis

1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

2 On page 11, after line 24, add the following:

3 "Section 6. Notwithstanding Section 5 of this Act, if a final, unappealable
4 judgment by a federal court in the cases of *Press Robinson, et al versus Kyle Ardoin,*
5 *in his official capacity as Secretary of State for Louisiana* (U.S. District Court,
6 Middle District of Louisiana, Civil Action 22-211-SDD-SDJ) consolidated with
7 *Edward Galmon, Sr., et al versus Kyle Ardoin, in his official capacity as Secretary*
8 *of State for Louisiana* (U. S. District Court, Middle District of Louisiana, Civil
9 Action 22-214-SDD-SDJ) does not declare the congressional plan enacted by Act 5
10 of the 2022 1st Extraordinary Session of the Legislature to be in violation of Section
11 2 of the Voting Rights Act of 1965, the following shall occur:

12 (A) The provisions of Sections 1 through 5 of this Act shall cease to be
13 effective.

14 (B) R.S. 18:1276 as enacted by Act No. 5 of the 2022 First Extraordinary
15 Session of the Legislature and Sections 4 and 5(B) of that Act are hereby reenacted
16 and shall become effective when the judgment in the cases is final and unappealable.

17 (C) The provisions of this Section shall not reduce the term of a
18 representative in the United States Congress."
