ACT 317 (SB 485) 2022 Regular Session

<u>Prior law</u> created the Delachaise Security and Improvement District in Orleans Parish as a political subdivision of the state for the purpose of aiding in crime prevention and providing for overall betterment of the district. Provided for district boundaries. Provided that the district must be governed by a board of commissioners composed as follows:

- (1) The president of the Delachaise Neighborhood Association (DNA).
- (2) Three members appointed by the governing board of the DNA.
- One member appointed by the member of the governing authority of the city of New Orleans who represents Council District B.

<u>New law</u> retains <u>prior law</u> but makes changes to the districts boundaries. <u>New law</u> also changes the board of commissioners as follows:

- (1) The presidents of the DNA and the Milan Neighborhood Association (MNA).
- (2) The governing board of the DNA shall appoint two members.
- (3) The governing board of the MNA shall appoint two members.
- One member appointed by the member of the governing authority of the city of New Orleans who represents Council District B.

Effective August 1, 2022.
