<u>Existing law</u>, providing for a sports injury management program for student athletes, states that pre-season games, such as scrimmages and jamborees, shall be subject to the modified guidelines of the American College of Sports Medicine and the National Athletic Trainers' Association regarding the heat acclimatization and wet bulb globe temperature policy.

<u>New law</u> provides that <u>existing law</u> shall also apply to regular season practices. <u>New law</u> provides that football jamborees and regular season games are exempt from <u>existing law</u>.

New law defines "interstate game", "intrastate game", "jamboree", and "regular season game".

Effective August 1, 2022.
