HIGHWAYS: Designates a certain portion of Louisiana Highway 384 in Calcasieu Parish as the "Captain Brian Bourgeois Memorial Traffic Circle"

1	AN ACT
2	To designate a portion of Louisiana Highway 384 in Calcasieu Parish as the "Captain Brian
3	Bourgeois Memorial Traffic Circle"; and to provide for related matters.
4	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
5	Section 1. The portion of Louisiana Highway 384, at the roundabout intersection of
6	Ham Reid Road and Big Lake Road, in Calcasieu Parish shall be known and is hereby
7	designated as the "Captain Brian Bourgeois Memorial Traffic Circle".
8	Section 2. The Department of Transportation and Development or its contractors are
9	hereby directed to erect and maintain appropriate signage reflecting this designation
10	provided local or private monies are received by the department equal to the department's
11	actual costs for material, fabrication, mounting posts, and installation of each sign, not to
12	exceed the sum of five hundred fifty dollars per sign.

Designates a portion of La. Hwy. 384, at the roundabout intersection of Ham Reid Road and Big Lake Road, in Calcasieu Parish as the "Captain Brian Bourgeois Memorial Traffic Circle".

Directs the Dept. of Transportation and Development (DOTD) to erect and maintain appropriate signage reflecting this highway designation provided local or private monies are received by the DOTD equal to its actual costs for material, fabrication, mounting posts, and installation of each sign, not to exceed the sum of \$550 per sign.
