Abstract: Provides for membership on the board of trustees of the Firefighters' Retirement System (FRS).

<u>Present law</u> provides that the FRS is governed by a board of trustees comprised of 10 members. <u>Proposed law</u> increases the number of trustees to 15.

<u>Present law</u> provides that one trustee is a fire chief elected by the fire chiefs. <u>Proposed law</u> provides for two such trustees.

<u>Present law</u> provides that two trustees are members of the Professional Fire Fighters Assoc. selected by the association's officers. <u>Proposed law</u> repeals present law.

<u>Present law</u> provides that one trustee is a system retiree selected by the board from nominations submitted by system retirees.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides for five retirees to be elected as trustees from geographic districts by the retirees who reside in the respective district.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides that one trustee is a surviving spouse of a deceased firefighter elected by retired members of FRS and spouses of deceased members.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides that one trustee is an active firefighter with at least six years of creditable service and a rank not above captain who is elected by the active members of FRS.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides for term limits for elected trustees; a person who has served more than two and one-half terms may not be elected to the succeeding term.

Effective upon signature of governor or lapse of time for gubernatorial action.
