Abstract: Creates the crime of unlawful swimming in certain waterways for minors and provides for penalties.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides that it shall be unlawful for any person who has not attained the age of 18 to swim in any river that generates hydroelectric power without wearing a Type I, Type II, Type III, or Type V personal flotation device approved by the U.S. Coast Guard.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides for the following penalties:

- (1) On a first conviction, the offender shall be fined not more than \$50 or the offender's parent or legal guardian may be imprisoned for not more than seven days, or both.
- (2) On a second conviction, the offender shall be fined not less than \$75 nor more than \$250 or the offender's parent or legal guardian may be imprisoned for not more than 30 days, or both.
- (3) On a third or subsequent conviction, the offender shall be fined not less than \$200 nor more \$550 or the offender's parent or legal guardian may be imprisoned for not more than 90 days, or both.
