Abstract: Provides for a civil fine for violation of notice requirement for imported crawfish and shrimp.

<u>Present law</u> requires all food service establishments that use a menu as a standard business practice and sell or provide cooked or prepared crawfish or shrimp that originate outside of the U.S. to disclose such crawfish or shrimp on menus and signs. <u>Present law</u> further provides the notice requirements for menus and signs.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides for a civil fine of not more than \$100 in certain instances of a violation of the notice requirement upon inspection of the business.
