<u>Present law</u> provides for the functions and duties of the Louisiana State Uniform Construction Code Council (council), including its primary duty to review and adopt the State Uniform Construction Code.

<u>Present law</u> provides that the council shall evaluate, adopt, and amend only the latest editions of certain international codes, including the International Residential Code (IRC).

<u>Present law</u> provides that the enforcement of the IRC applies only with respect to new construction, reconstruction, additions to homes previously built to the IRC, and extensive alterations; however, a municipality, parish, or regional planning commission may enforce certain provisions of the IRC at its option.

<u>Present law</u> prohibits the council from adopting and enforcing certain provisions of the IRC relative to a fire protection sprinkler system in one- or two-family dwellings.

<u>Proposed law</u> retains <u>present law</u> and adds that the council shall not enforce any provision of the IRC that requires an annual inspection of a backflow prevention device. Allows a municipality or parish to adopt an ordinance or other regulation requiring an annual inspection of a backflow prevention device.

Effective August 1, 2023.
