



1 House Bill No. 165 further requires the legislature to provide the procedures, form, and  
2 manner by which the people may exercise these rights.

3       THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislature of Louisiana does hereby  
4 request the House Committee on House and Governmental Affairs and the Senate  
5 Committee on Senate and Governmental Affairs to meet and function as a joint committee  
6 to study and make recommendations with respect to the implementation of initiative and  
7 referendum in Louisiana, including recommended legislation, if and when the proposed  
8 amendment to the Constitution of Louisiana contained in House Bill No. 165 of this 2023  
9 Regular Session of the Legislature is adopted at a statewide election and becomes effective.

10       BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the joint committee shall report its findings to  
11 the legislature no later than thirty days prior to the convening of the 2024 Regular Session  
12 of the Legislature.
