**Abstract:** Provides relative to the designation of the marshal of the city court of Sulphur and qualifications of deputy constables.

<u>Present law</u> provides that a marshal or constable, except the marshal of the city court of Lake Charles, may be designated for each city court.

<u>Proposed law</u> adds an exception for the marshal of the city of Sulphur and designates the marshal as the ward four marshal.

<u>Present law</u> provides that a deputy constable must be a resident of the parish within which the elected constable's ward is located.

<u>Proposed law</u> changes the requirement that the deputy constable be a resident of the parish within which the elected constable's ward is located and requires the deputy constable to be a resident of this state.

## Summary of Amendments Adopted by House

The Committee Amendments Proposed by House Committee on Judiciary to the original bill:

- 1. Remove provisions which provide for the compensation of certain marshals and constables.
- 2. Change <u>from</u> the requirement that the deputy constable be a resident of the parish within which the elected constable's ward is located <u>to</u> the requirement that the deputy constable be a resident of this state.
