2	To designate Tuesday, May 9, 2023, as Acadiana Red and White Day at the state capitol.
3	WHEREAS, One Acadiana, the University of Louisiana at Lafayette, and the
4	University of Louisiana at Lafayette Alumni Association are bringing Acadiana's economic
5	development, chamber, civic, business, and higher education partners together for Acadiana
6	Red and White Day to promote the shared interests of the Acadiana region; and
7	WHEREAS, these leaders are focused every day on priorities to advance the
8	Acadiana region and the state of Louisiana and have made tremendous strides to enhance
9	economic competitiveness, talent development, and quality of place through collaboration
10	and innovation with legislators and other public officials; and
11	WHEREAS, Acadiana Red and White Day provides an opportunity to advocate for
12	such priorities and celebrate shared achievements; and
13	WHEREAS, a top priority of the region's leaders is communicating the crucial role
14	of our higher education institutions in improving economic competitiveness, cultivating
15	talent, and boosting quality of life in each region and the state; and
16	WHEREAS, Acadiana is coming together to recognize the ongoing successes of the
17	University of Louisiana at Lafayette in its academic, athletic, and research endeavors; and
