- 10 "(ii) The removal of a dead unborn child or the inducement or delivery of the 11 uterine contents in case of a positive diagnosis, certified in writing in the woman's medical record along with the results of an obstetric ultrasound test, that the 12 pregnancy has ended or is in the unavoidable and untreatable process of ending due 13 14 to spontaneous miscarriage, also known in medical terminology as spontaneous 15 abortion, missed abortion, inevitable abortion, incomplete abortion, or septic abortion, including a spontaneous, profound, and irremediable complication of the 16 17 pregnancy that makes the carriage to term of the unborn child unlikely due to the profound and irremediable spontaneous complication." 18
