<u>Present law</u> establishes the "Right-to-Know" law to inform the public of the risks and effects of certain hazardous materials and provides for certain reporting requirements and definitions.

<u>Present law</u> provides for the reporting of certain information and for penalties related to a release of natural gas from distribution lines, the threshold for which is a reportable quantity of one thousand pounds or more of natural gas.

<u>Proposed law maintains present law and changes the reportable quantity for releases of natural gas from distribution lines from 1,000 pounds or more to 42,000 pounds or more.</u>

Effective August 1, 2023.

- 1. Removes natural gas pipeline exceptions to definitions of "facility" and "owner or operator."
- 2. Removes natural gas pipeline exception to alternative reporting procedures.
