COMMENDATIONS. Commends Senator Sharon Hewitt for her years of distinguished public service.

A RESOLUTION

2	To commend the Honorable Sharon Woodall Hewitt for her years of distinguished public
3	service and to express enduring gratitude for her outstanding contributions made on
4	behalf of the constituents of the parishes of Orleans, Plaquemines, St. Bernard, and
5	St. Tammany, and the state of Louisiana, particularly during her tenure as a
6	distinguished member of the Louisiana Senate representing District 1.
7	WHEREAS, Sharon W. Hewitt is a public servant whose excellence as a state
8	legislator has merited her election to two terms in the Louisiana Senate, during which time
9	she used every opportunity to serve the citizens of her district and the state in an honorable
10	and dedicated manner; and
11	WHEREAS, a lifelong resident of South Louisiana, Senator Hewitt is a graduate of
12	Barbe High School in Lake Charles, where she earned the honor of valedictorian, and of
13	Louisiana State University, where she earned a Bachelor of Science in Mechanical
14	Engineering; and
15	WHEREAS, upon the completion of her formal education, Senator Hewitt embarked
16	on a trailblazing career path as a woman in STEM, working offshore on a drilling rig in the
17	Gulf of Mexico for Shell Oil; and
18	WHEREAS, undaunted by the challenges presented to her in the field, Senator

1	Hewitt climbed the ranks at Shell Oil, eventually becoming an executive whose bold,
2	creative solutions to complex problems and relentless work ethic helped the company
3	navigate the oil bust of the 1980s; and
4	WHEREAS, Senator Hewitt continued to leave a legacy as one of the first female
5	executives at a major oil and gas company, managing Shell's central deepwater assets in the
6	Gulf of Mexico where she oversaw roughly ten percent of the oil production in the United
7	States and was entrusted with oversight of billions of dollars in assets; and
8	WHEREAS, after many successful years at Shell, in 1999 Senator Hewitt made the
9	personal sacrifice to put her family first and dedicated herself to spending more time with
10	her children; and
11	WHEREAS, during the next several years as a full-time mom, Senator Hewitt
12	became a fixture with the local Parent Teacher Association (PTA) where she was active in
13	efforts to improve Slidell community schools and build parks and playgrounds for which she
14	was bestowed the National PTA Life Achievement Award in recognition of her leadership;

16	WHEREAS, Senator Hewitt began her public service career with her appointment
17	to the St. Tammany Parish Recreation District No. 16 Board from 2012 to 2015; and
18	WHEREAS, motivated by a desire to improve the state's education system and
19	economy, Senator Hewitt launched a successful campaign to represent Senate District 1 in
