13	(ii) The cannabinoid profile by percentage of weight.
14	(c) A potency test of the final product indicating the serving size, total THC
15	per serving, total number of servings, and total THC per package, identified as
16	milligrams per grams.
17	(2) The application for registration shall include <u>a notarized</u> verification that
18	the product was produced from hemp and is in compliance with the provisions of this
19	Part. Acceptable forms of verification shall be determined by the department and
20	may include a copy of the hemp grower or processor's license.
21	(3) Any application for registration that does not meet the criteria provided

in this Subsection that was approved by the department prior to June 16, 2022, may
be used in Louisiana until July 1, 2023."
