## **EXPENDITURE EXPLANATION**

Proposed law allows the Calcasieu Parish I-10 Bridge Authority to receive and utilize monies within the Megaprojects Leverage Fund designated for the I-10 Calcasieu River Bridge and I-10 Improvement Account to reduce or eliminate the cost of tolling for citizens within the five parish area of southwest Louisiana. <u>Propose law may result in a significant increase</u> in expenditures out of the Megaproject Leverage Fund; however, the timing of expenditures for this purpose are <u>speculative and may occur outside of the five-year window of this fiscal note.</u>

The proposed law would require an intergovernmental transfer to the authority; the LFO is not certain how this will be operationalized. Proposed law allows the Department of Transportation and Development (DOTD) to adopt rules and regulations in the event a tolling mechanism is established for the Calcasieu River Bridge to implement this measure.

The LFO assumes the funds will require an appropriation by the legislature to the authority for this purpose. To the extent funds are used to reduce or eliminate the costs of tolling for parish citizens, funds available for other allowable uses associated with the Megaproject Leverage Fund will be reduced.

## **REVENUE EXPLANATION**

There is no anticipated direct material effect on governmental revenues as a result of this measure.
