GAMBLING/CHARITABLE: Provides relative to licenses for certain raffle games

Synopsis of Senate Amendments

1. Provides that the prize value <u>rather than</u> the proceeds of the single games shall not exceed \$10,000.

Digest of Bill as Finally Passed by Senate

<u>Proposed law</u> provides for a limited raffle license for certain raffle games. Requires the office of charitable gaming within the Dept. of Revenue to promulgate rules relative to the issuance of such licenses.

<u>Proposed law</u> further provides that the provisions of <u>present law</u> (R.S. 4:705(2)(c)) and 714(F)(1)), relative to the establishment, assessment, and collection of certain fees and proceeds from gaming sessions deposited into a bank account, shall not apply to any limited license issued pursuant to <u>proposed law</u>.

<u>Proposed law</u> applies only to single raffle games as defined in <u>present law</u> (R.S. 4:707(A)(1)), and limits the prize value to \$10,000, instead of limiting the proceeds to \$10,000 as provided in <u>present law</u>.
