Abstract: Authorizes certain law enforcement officers employed by certain public postsecondary education institutions to receive state supplemental pay at the rate of \$500 per month.

<u>Present law</u> (R.S. 40:1667.1(A)) provides for state supplemental pay of \$500 per month for any full-time police officer employed by any municipality or by the Chitimacha Tribe of La., Coushatta Tribe of La., or the Tunica-Biloxi Tribe of La., who has passed a council-certified training program and who has completed one year of service.

<u>Present law</u> further provides for state supplemental pay of \$500 per month for certain police officers who provide services while patrolling levees, waterways, riverfront areas, and bridges within the city of New Orleans, who have passed a council-certified training program, and who have completed one year of service.

<u>Proposed law</u> authorizes state supplemental pay of \$500 per month for certain commissioned law enforcement officers employed on a full-time basis by the following postsecondary education institutions who have passed a council-certified training program, and who have completed one year of service:

- (1) Nicholls State University at Thibodaux.
- (2) Southern University and Agricultural and Mechanical College at Baton Rouge.
- (3) University of La. at Lafayette.
- (4) Southeastern La. University.

<u>Proposed law</u> further provides that if state supplemental pay is increased for other law enforcement officers eligible pursuant to <u>present law</u>, then the supplemental pay pursuant to <u>proposed law</u> shall be increased by the same amount.

Effective when an act of the La. legislature containing a specific appropriation of monies for the implementation of the provisions of proposed law becomes effective.

Summary of Amendments Adopted by House

The Committee Amendments Proposed by <u>House Committee on Appropriations</u> to the <u>original</u> bill:

- 1. Add commissioned law enforcement officers employed by Southeastern La. University, University of La. at Lafayette, and Southern University and Agricultural and Mechanical College at Baton Rouge.
- 2. Make <u>proposed law</u> effective when an Act of the legislature containing a specific appropriation of monies for the implementation of <u>proposed law</u> becomes effective.
- 3. Make technical changes.
