

EXPENDITURE EXPLANATION

The LFO does not anticipate a direct material effect on governmental expenditures as a result of this measure. Present law allows for local education agencies (LEAs) to participate in a local review process of textbooks and other instructional materials. Proposed law requires LEAs to submit materials approved through this process to the Louisiana Department of Education (LDE) in order for materials to be recognized as high quality for all purposes. No later than six months following such a submission, LDE is required to issue a report regarding the alignment of submitted materials with state content standards. LDE reports there will be no additional costs to the department to comply with proposed law.
