1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

- 2 On page 1, line 8, after "definitions;" and before "to" insert "to prohibit members of the
- 3 program from prescribing certain medications and hormones;"
- 4 AMENDMENT NO. 2

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- 5 On page 6, between lines 7 and 8, add the following:
 - "H. Members of the pharmacy benefit manager quality incentive program shall not knowingly engage in any of the following acts that attempt to alter a minor's appearance in an attempt to validate a minor's perception of his sex if the minor's perception is inconsistent with his sex:
 - (1) The prescription or administration of gonadotropin-releasing hormone analogues or other synthetic drugs used to stop luteinizing hormone and follicle stimulating hormone secretion, synthetic antiandrogen drugs used to block the androgen receptor, or any drug to suppress or delay normal puberty.
- 15 (2) The prescription or administration of testosterone, estrogen, or 16 progesterone, in amounts greater than would normally be produced 17 endogenously in a healthy individual of the same age and sex."
