2	To enact R.S. 18:586, relative to vacancies in an elected office; to provide relative to the
3	retirement or resignation of an elected official; to provide relative to appointments
4	and elections to fill such a vacancy; to provide a prohibition; to provide for an
5	effective date; and to provide for related matters.
6	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
7	Section 1. R.S. 18:586 is hereby enacted to read as follows:
8	§586. Vacancies caused by retirement or resignation; prohibitions
9	A. No elected official who has retired or resigned from state or local elective
10	office shall be appointed to succeed himself in the office from which he retired or
11	resigned.
12	B. No elected official who has retired or resigned from state or local elective
13	office shall be eligible as a candidate at an election called to fill the vacancy created
14	by the retirement or resignation of the elected official.
15	Section 2. This Act shall become effective upon signature by the governor or, if not
16	signed by the governor, upon expiration of the time for bills to become law without signature
17	by the governor, as provided by Article III, Section 18 of the Constitution of Louisiana. If
18	vetoed by the governor and subsequently approved by the legislature, this Act shall become
19	effective on the day following such approval.
