Authorizes the University of Louisiana System to establish tuition and fees for a Doctor of Physical Therapy program at the

University of Louisiana at Monroe

Proposed law authorizes the University of Louisiana System (ULS) Board of Supervisors to charge tuition and other fee amounts for students enrolled in the Doctor of Physical Therapy (DPT) program at the University of Louisiana at Monroe (ULM).

The ULM School of Allied Health was granted initial candidate for accreditation status by the Commission on Accreditation in Physical Therapy Education (CAPTE) on October 25, 2022 which will allow the institution to begin enrolling a cohort of students in a Doctor of Physical Therapy program in the Fall of 2023.

**EXPENDITURE EXPLANATION** 

There is no anticipated direct material effect on governmental expenditures as a result of this measure.

## **REVENUE EXPLANATION**

ULM will begin collecting tuition and fees from a 48 student annual cohort enrolling in the newly created program. Proposed law will allow the university to charge a new \$4,000 professional fee to students enrolled in the DPT program per semester, pending authorization from the ULS Board of Supervisors. The DPT curriculum will typically span 8 semesters over the course of three years beginning in the Fall semester. The estimated revenue from an individual student would be \$12,000 in year one, \$12,000 in year two, and \$8,000 in year three assuming the student enrolls in the Fall, Spring, and Summer semesters. A single cohort of 48 students would then bring in \$576,000 in year one, \$576,000 in year two, and \$384,000 in year three, for a total of \$1,536,000. Once fully implemented, the program will support three simultaneous cohorts. The first is slated to enroll in Fall 2023 with an additional added in Fall 2024 and another in Fall 2025. A carryover of 4 students (\$16,000) is factored into the revenue estimate for a potential 9th semester for any students needing additional time to complete the program. The breakdown of the subsequent five fiscal years is depicted in the table below:
