is projected due to the budgeted means of finance or estimated revenue collections being

insufficient to finance projected expenditures, the department shall inform the committee of

any other sources of revenues that may be available or adjustments in expenditures that

could be implemented within the department to aid in alleviating the projected deficit. Also

beginning with the second report and continuing in each report submitted monthly thereafter,

the department shall delineate, in the same manner as presented in the first report of the

fiscal year, the initial allocation of payments, total projected expenditures, and year-to-date

expenditures in Fiscal Year 2023-2024 for each allocation within the programs, the supplemental or directed payment programs, the supplemental or directed payments and

uncompensated care costs payments to the LSU Public Private Partnership hospitals, and the

total expenditures on the Managed Care Incentive Program.
