A RESOLUTION

To designate Monday, June 5, 2023, as Louisiana Unclaimed Property Day in recognition

of the fiftieth anniversary of Louisiana's unclaimed property program.

WHEREAS, Act No. 146 of the 1972 Regular Session of the Legislature created the

Louisiana unclaimed property program and was signed into law by Governor Edwin

Edwards on July 3, 1972; and

WHEREAS, unclaimed property consists of abandoned financial assets such as

checking and savings accounts, unpaid wages, securities, life insurance payouts, uncashed

checks, and the proceeds of safe deposit boxes that are without activity for a certain period

of time; and

WHEREAS, money was first received into the unclaimed property program in 1973;

and

WHEREAS, over the past fifty years, Louisiana's unclaimed property program has

issued 1.38 million unclaimed property checks, totaling \$727 million, to the rightful owners.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the House of Representatives of the

Legislature of Louisiana does hereby designate Monday, June 5, 2023, as Louisiana

Unclaimed Property Day in recognition of the fiftieth anniversary of the Louisiana

unclaimed property program.
