**Abstract:** Requires a chairman to disclose to the Speaker within 24 hours of calling an interim meeting that causes a conflict requiring the filing of a legislative continuance or extension by the chairman.

<u>Proposed House Rule</u> requires a chairman of any committee or task force, including any subcommittee thereof, to disclose to the Speaker, no later than 24 hours after calling a meeting during the interim, if the chairman knows or reasonably should know the meeting will cause a conflict that will cause or has caused the chairman to file a motion for a legislative continuance or extension of time pursuant to <u>present law</u> (R.S. 13:4163) on a previously scheduled court matter or deadline. Further requires that the disclosure include the reasons why the meeting could not have been scheduled on a different date.
