MTR VEHICLE/TRUCKS: Urges and requests the office of motor vehicles, the Louisiana State Police, the Federal Motor Carrier Safety Administration, and the Safety Management Council to work together regarding consistency of regulations enforced and followed by commercial motor vehicle companies within Louisiana

2	To urge and request the office of motor vehicles, the Louisiana State Police, the Federal
3	Motor Carrier Safety Administration, and the Safety Management Council to work
4	together to host educational forums to ensure regulations are being consistently
5	enforced and followed by commercial motor vehicle companies within Louisiana.
6	WHEREAS, commercial trucking regulations should be consistently and fairly
7	enforced throughout Louisiana; and
8	WHEREAS, inconsistent enforcement of regulations creates an unfair system in
9	which one commercial vehicle operator may have an advantage another does not; and
10	WHEREAS, the inconsistent enforcement may result in accidents, which are a
11	blemish on the industry; and
12	WHEREAS, consistent enforcement of and education about regulations helps to
13	ensure regulations are being followed; and
14	WHEREAS, the failure of commercial motor vehicle companies to abide by
15	regulations increases the potential for unsafe operations and for traffic accidents; and
16	WHEREAS, traffic accidents involving commercial motor vehicles are a particular
17	threat to public safety; and
18	WHEREAS, it is vital that commercial motor vehicle laws and regulations be strictly
19	adhered to by commercial motor vehicle companies; and

1	WHEREAS, the Louisiana Motor Transport Association's Safety Management
2	Council is the national organization dedicated to advancing safe policies, practices, and
3	technology; and
4	WHEREAS, additionally, the Louisiana Motor Transport Association's Safety
5	Management Council is further dedicated to effective risk management and accident and
6	injury prevention in the trucking industry; and
7	WHEREAS, the Federal Motor Carrier Safety Administration is the lead federal
8	government agency responsible for regulating and providing safety oversight of commercial
9	motor vehicles, and its mission is to reduce crashes, injuries, and fatalities involving large
10	trucks and buses; and
11	WHEREAS, the office of motor vehicles and the Louisiana State Police are
12	responsible for ensuring commercial motor vehicles are operating in a safe and legal manner
13	within Louisiana.
14	THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the House of Representatives of the
15	Legislature of Louisiana does hereby urge and request the office of motor vehicles, the
16	Louisiana State Police, the Federal Motor Carrier Safety Administration, and the Safety
17	Management Council to work together to host educational forums to ensure regulations are
18	being consistently enforced and followed by commercial motor vehicle companies within
19	Louisiana.
20	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this Resolution be transmitted to the
21	commissioner of the office of motor vehicles, the superintendent of the Louisiana State
22	Police, the secretary of the Department of Public Safety, the Southern Service Center for the
23	Federal Motor Carrier Safety Administration, and the executive director of the Louisiana
24	Motor Transport Association's Safety Management Council.
