1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

2 On page 1, line 11, after "procedures;" and before "and" insert "to provide for reporting
3 requirements; to provide for effectiveness;"

4 AMENDMENT NO. 2

5 On page 40, line 13, change "Implementation" to "Implementation; reporting requirements"

6 AMENDMENT NO. 3

7 On page 41, between lines 10 and 11, insert the following:

8 **"D.(1) The commissioner shall report all of the following quarterly to the**
9 **House Committee on Commerce and the Senate Committee on Commerce,**
10 **Consumer Protection and International Affairs:**

11 **(a) The number of applications for each type of license.**

12 **(b) The number of applicants who currently have a money transmission**
13 **license.**

14 **(c) The number of permits granted.**

15 **(d) The number of applicants who have been denied.**

16 **(e) A list of fees that were assessed during application.**

17 **(2) The quarterly report shall be submitted on the first day of July,**
18 **October, January, and March of each calendar year."**

19 AMENDMENT NO. 4

20 On page 41, after line 11, insert the following:

21 "Section 3. The provisions of this Act shall terminate on July 1, 2025.

23 Section 4. This Act shall become effective upon signature by the governor or, if not
24 signed by the governor, upon expiration of the time for bills to become law without signature
25 by the governor, as provided by Article III, Section 18 of the Constitution of Louisiana. If
26 vetoed by the governor and subsequently approved by the legislature, this Act shall become
27 effective on the day following such approval."
