Amendments proposed by Senate Committee on Revenue and Fiscal Affairs to Reengrossed House Bill No. 131 by Representative McCormick

1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, line 2, after "R.S. 40:1379.3(B)(2)(a)" and before the comma "," insert "and
(I)(2)"

4 AMENDMENT NO. 2

5 On page 1, line 6, after "concealed handgun permits;"insert "to require providing of 6 identification to a police officer when carrying a concealed handgun;"

7 AMENDMENT NO. 3

8 On page 2, line 7, after "R.S. 40:1379.3(B)(2)(a)" and before the comma "," insert "and 9 (I)(2)"

10 AMENDMENT NO. 4

11 On page 2, between lines 20 and 21, insert the following:

12 "(I)(1) 13 (2) A permittee armed with a handgun in accordance with this Section or a 14 person carrying a weapon pursuant to R.S. 14:95(M) shall notify any police officer 15 who approaches the permittee in an official manner or with an identified official 16 purpose that he has a weapon on his person, submit to a pat down, and allow the 17 officer to temporarily disarm him. Whenever a law enforcement officer is made 18 aware that an individual is carrying a concealed handgun and the law enforcement 19 officer has reasonable grounds to believe that the individual is under the influence 20 of either alcohol or a controlled dangerous substance, the law enforcement officer may take temporary possession of the handgun, require the furnishing of the 21 individual's valid, current driver's license or identification card issued by the state of 22 23 Louisiana, and request submission of the individual to a department-certified 24 chemical test for determination of the chemical status of the individual. Whenever 25 a law enforcement officer is made aware that an individual is behaving in a criminally negligent manner as defined under the provisions of this Section, or is 26 negligent in the carrying of a concealed handgun as provided for in R.S. 40:1382, the 27 28 law enforcement officer may seize the handgun, until adjudication by a judge, if the 29 individual is issued a summons or arrested under the provisions of R.S. 40:1382. Failure by the permittee to comply with the provisions of this Paragraph shall result 30 31 in a six-month automatic suspension of the permit. 32 * *"
