## Keyword and oneliner of the instrument as it left the House

STATE AGENCIES: Provides for the collection of fees associated with facilitating an electronic signature or authorization

## **Report adopts Senate amendments to:**

1. Change the effective date to signature by the governor or lapse of time for gubernatorial action.

#### **Report rejects Senate amendments which would have:**

- 1. Required technology approved by the treasurer pursuant to <u>proposed law</u> to ensure the privacy and security of personal and sensitive confidential information and to meet certain specified criteria.
- 2. Made technical changes

## Digest of the bill as proposed by the Conference Committee

<u>Proposed law</u> allows a state entity to charge an optional convenience fee for use of an electronic signature in connection with official documents. Provides for the payment of the convenience fee by credit card, debit card, or other electronic payment approved pursuant to <u>present law</u> (R.S. 49:316.1). Provides for the convenience fee to be approved by the Senate Committee on Revenue and Fiscal Affairs and the House Committee on Ways and Means.

Effective upon signature by the governor or lapse of time for gubernatorial action.
