Page 1 of Increases the amount of supplemental pay for eligible law enforcement and fire service employees. (7/1/23)

Proposed law increases supplemental pay for certain law enforcement officers and firefighters by \$100, from the current amount of \$500 to \$600 per month. Proposed law includes eligible firefighters, municipal police officers, deputy sheriffs, certain tribal police, harbor police, fireboat employee, and bridge police. Proposed law increases supplemental pay for every justice of the peace and constable for each justice of the peace court by \$20, from the current amount of \$100 to \$120 per month. Proposed law effective July 1, 2023. Proposed law directs the LA Legislative Auditor to audit the program and report findings and recommendations by 2/01/2024. Proposed law effective July 1, 2023.

## **EXPENDITURE EXPLANATION**

Proposed law will increase annual SGF expenditures in Other Requirements Schedule 20-966 - Supplemental Pay by \$23,553,120 to provide supplemental payments beginning in FY 24 as follows: (1) \$100 per month increase to existing eligible law enforcement officers and firefighters as well as \$20 per month increase to existing justices of the peace and constables; and (2) a one-time increase in travel expenditures, assumed to be SGF, in the LA Legislative Auditor. # Existing Police Officers, Deputy Sheriffs, and Firefighters - \$23,226,000

Proposed law will increase annual SGF expenditures in Schedule 20-966 - Supplemental Pay by \$23.2 M to provide supplemental payments increase of \$100 per month to eligible firefighters, police officers, deputy sheriffs, certain tribal police, harbor police, and fireboat personnel beginning FY 24. The \$100 increase would bring the current supplemental payment amount for law enforcement officers from \$500 per month to \$600 per month (from \$6,000 per year to \$7,200 per year).

Currently, there are an average of 19,355 (5,650 firefighters, 5,405 municipal police offers, and 8,300 sheriff deputies receiving monthly supplemental pay for a total annual cost of \$116.1 M in FY 23. The proposed law requires an increase in supplemental pay beginning in FY 24 of \$23,226,000 SGF (\$139.4 M for \$600 per month - \$116.1 M for \$500 per month).

## Existing Justices of the Peace and Constables - \$177,120

Proposed law will increase annual SGF expenditures in Other Requirements Schedule 20-966 - Supplemental Pay by \$177,120 to provide supplemental payments increase of \$20 per month to eligible justices of the peace and constables beginning FY 24. The \$20 increase would bring the current supplemental payment amount for justices of the peace and constables from \$100 per month to \$120 per month (from \$1,200 per year to \$1,440 per year).

Currently, there are an average of 738 justices of the peace and constables receiving monthly supplemental pay for a total annual cost of \$885,600 in FY 23. The proposed law requires an increase in supplemental pay beginning in FY 24 of \$177,120 SGF (\$1,062,720 for \$120 per month - \$885,600 for \$100 per month).

Note: The General Appropriations Bill (HB 1) for FY 24 has a recommended \$23.4 M SGF increase in supplemental pay for law enforcement personnel, which provides funding for the additional \$100 per month supplemental payment to local law enforcement and firefighters as well as an additional \$20 per month supplemental payment for Constables and Justices of the Peace.

## LA Legislative Auditor - \$150,000

The proposed law directs the LA Legislative Auditor (LLA) to examine, investigate, and audit the state's supplemental payment program and eligible recipients. Afterward, the LLA is required to make recommendations on modifications to the supplemental program in a report to the House Committee on Appropriations and the Senate Committee on Finance no later than February 1, 2024. Under present law, the LLA is responsible for conducting regularly scheduled performance audits on each executive branch department and assesses annual fees on all departments to fund audit services. LLA has reported needing \$150,000 for travel expenditures to examine and perform audits on local governments, sheriffs, and municipal police departments.

## Local Governmental Entities - Increase

Proposed law will increase Local Funds expenditures by an indeterminable amount as state supplemental payments are included in the pensionable earnings used in the calculation of retirement benefits.
