<u>Prior law</u> defined adult as an individual who had attained the age of 18 and a minor as an individual who had not attained the age of 18.

<u>New law</u> changes the definition of an adult to an individual who has attained the age of 25 and a minor as an individual who has not attained the age of 25.

<u>Prior law</u> provided for the termination of custodianship upon the minor's attainment of the age of 18.

<u>New law</u> provides for the termination of custodianship upon the minor's attainment of the age of 25.
