20 "(I)(1) 21 (2) A permittee armed with a handgun in accordance with this Section or a 22 person carrying a weapon pursuant to R.S. 14:95(M) shall notify any police officer 23 who approaches the permittee in an official manner or with an identified official purpose that he has a weapon on his person, submit to a pat down, and allow the 24 25 officer to temporarily disarm him. The police officer may require the furnishing 26 of an individual's valid, current driver's license or identification card issued by 27 the state of Louisiana. Whenever a law enforcement officer is made aware that an 28 individual is carrying a concealed handgun and the law enforcement officer has 29 reasonable grounds to believe that the individual is under the influence of either 30 alcohol or a controlled dangerous substance, the law enforcement officer may take 31 temporary possession of the handgun, require the furnishing of the individual's 32 valid, current driver's license or identification card issued by the state of Louisiana, and request submission of the individual to a department-certified 33 chemical test for determination of the chemical status of the individual. Whenever 34 35 a law enforcement officer is made aware that an individual is behaving in a criminally negligent manner as defined under the provisions of this Section, or is 36 37 negligent in the carrying of a concealed handgun as provided for in R.S. 40:1382, the law enforcement officer may seize the handgun, until adjudication by a judge, if the 38 39 individual is issued a summons or arrested under the provisions of R.S. 40:1382.

1	Failure by the permittee to comply with the provisions of this Paragraph shall result
2	in a six-month automatic suspension of the permit.

8	G.(1) The Department of Public Safety and Corrections, office of state police,
9	shall create and maintain a website portal for the online handgun education course.
10	(2) The nine segments required under Subsection (D) of this Section shall be
11	available in the portal.
12	(3) Completion of the nine segments through the portal within a sixty-day
13	period shall be required in addition to meeting the requirements of R.S. 14:95(M).
14	(4) The Department of Public Safety and Corrections, office of state police,
15	shall maintain a list of all applicants for a concealed handgun permit that have
16	completed the online handgun education course.
17	(5) The Department of Public Safety and Corrections may promulgate rules
18	for the implementation of this Subsection."
