DRUGS: Provides relative to the over-the-counter sale and purchase of the drug ivermectin without a prescription

1	AN ACT
2	To enact Part XI of Chapter 4 of Title 40 of the Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950, to be
3	comprised of R.S. 40:1051 through 1053, relative to the over-the-counter sale and
4	purchase of the drug ivermectin; to provide for the sale and purchase of ivermectin
5	without a prescription; to provide for definitions; and to provide for related matters.
6	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
7	Section 1. Part XI of Chapter 4 of Title 40 of the Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950,
8	comprised of R.S. 40:1051 through 1053, is hereby enacted to read as follows:
9	PART XI. IVERMECTIN ACCESS LAW
10	<u>§1051. Short title</u>
11	This Part shall be known and may be cited as the "Ivermectin Access Law".
12	<u>§1052. Definitions</u>
13	As used in this Part, the following terms have the following meanings:
14	(1) "Healthcare professional" is any person who is licensed in accordance
15	with the provisions of Chapter 15 of Title 37 of the Louisiana Revised Statutes of
16	<u>1950.</u>
17	(2) "Ivermectin" is a Food and Drug Administration-approved antiparasitic
18	drug used to treat several untreated tropical diseases and infections caused by some
19	parasitic worms and head lice and skin conditions like rosacea.

CODING: Words in struck through type are deletions from existing law; words <u>underscored</u> are additions.

1	(3) "Over-the-counter medication" means medication that may be legally
2	sold and purchased without a prescription.
3	§1053. Over-the-counter distribution; ivermectin
4	A. Notwithstanding any other law to the contrary, ivermectin suitable for
5	human use may be sold or purchased as an over-the-counter medication in this state.
6	B. The sale or purchase as provided for in Subsection A of this Section shall
7	not require a prescription from any healthcare professional.

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Abstract: Provides for the over-the-counter sale and purchase of ivermectin without a prescription from any healthcare professional.

Proposed law shall be known and may be cited as the "Ivermectin Access Law".

<u>Proposed law</u> defines "ivermectin" as a Food and Drug Administration-approved antiparasitic drug used to treat several untreated tropical diseases and infections caused by some parasitic worms and head lice and skin conditions like rosacea. <u>Proposed law</u> also defines "over-the-counter medication" as medication that may be legally sold and purchased without a prescription.

<u>Proposed law</u> defines "healthcare professional" in accordance with the provisions of <u>present</u> <u>law</u>.

<u>Proposed law</u> permits the sale and purchase of ivermectin suitable for human use as an over-the-counter medication. <u>Proposed law</u> further provides that such sale or purchase shall not require a prescription from any healthcare professional.
