9	A. There is hereby created a board of directors for the school, sometimes
10	hereinafter referred to as the "board". The board shall be composed of twenty-four
11	members as follows:

16	Section 2. This Act shall become effective upon signature by the governor or, if not

Edmonds

<u>Present law</u> provides that the board of directors for Jimmy D. Long School for Math, Science, and the Arts is composed of 24 members, including two members of the Senate Committee on Education to be appointed by the chairman.

<u>Proposed law</u> retains <u>present law</u> and further provides that the board include two members of the Senate Committee on Education to be appointed by the chairman or his designees.

Effective upon signature of the governor or lapse of time for gubernatorial action.
