FUNDS/FUNDING-BUDGET, ST: Provides relative to classification of certain revenues received by the state

1 AN ACT

2 To amend and reenact R.S. 17:1519.6(E)(1), relative to certain state revenues; to reclassify
3 revenues from certain sources; to authorize appropriation of such revenues to the
4 Louisiana Department of Health; and to provide for related matters.

5 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

6 Section 1. R.S. 17:1519.6(E)(1) is hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows:

7 §1519.6. Funding and budget

8 * * *

9 E.(1) Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, the LSU Health
10 Sciences Center-health care services division, the LSU Health Sciences Center-New
11 Orleans, and the LSU Health Sciences Center-Shreveport are hereby authorized and
12 directed to deposit into the state general fund all receipts of lease payments for the
13 public-private partnership leases of state hospital buildings and equipment net of
14 clinic and hospital lease payments made by the LSU Health Sciences Center-health
15 care services division. Beginning with Fiscal Year 2025-2026, all such revenues
16 shall be categorized as fees and self-generated revenue available for appropriation
17 to the Louisiana Department of Health.

Abstract: Classifies revenues from certain rental payments received by state hospitals as fees and self-generated revenues available for appropriation to the La. Dept. of Health (LDH).

Present law places responsibility for state hospitals with La. State University. Proposed law retains present law.

Present law directs the LSU Health Sciences Center-health care services division, the LSU Health Sciences Center-New Orleans, and the LSU Health Sciences Center-Shreveport to deposit into the state general fund all receipts of lease payments for the public-private partnership leases of state hospital buildings and equipment, net of certain payments made by the LSU Health Sciences Center-health care services division. Proposed law retains present law. Further requires that beginning with Fiscal Year 2025-2026, all such revenues be categorized as fees and self-generated revenue available for appropriation to the (LDH). (Amends R.S. 17:1519.6(E)(1))
